<p>Physical Requirements (including work conditions):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be able to lift and carry objects up to 50 lbs frequently • Must be able to pass drug test as Federal Aviation Association (FAA) requires random drug testing • Must have the ability to stand for prolonged periods of time
